First of all, I would like to say thank you to everyone who was actively integrated in enabling me this semester abroad. Namely, the international office in person of Mirjana Matic-Schädler who was all the time available for issues occurred before, during and after this semester. I also want to say thank you to my Executive Director of the MSc Finance programme Florian Schaller and the whole team of the Kozminski University International Office. It was an unforgettable experience where I could enhance a lot of skills and met so many nice people from all around the world.

### **Accommodation:**

Kozminski University does not have an own student dormitory but helps the incoming students in finding accommodation. Furthermore, the international office is a very helpful contact in every step of your exchange semester. Warsaw is divided by a river called Vistula. The one part where the campus is situated is called Praga. Thus, it is a little bit outside the city center, however directly connected to tram lines. From the central station it takes you about 30 Minutes to get there by tram. As recommended by a fellow student who was at Kozminski previously, I searched for a room in the real center. Best approach for this are Facebook groups you can find easily by searching for accommodation and Erasmus in Warsaw. I could reach everything by feet and also by public transportation. However, the city center is a more expensive living environment.

### **Preparation:**


Before the official start of the semester, Kozminski university sent us all necessary information in a short booklet as well as our access data to the virtual university. It was very helpful before starting there. The first week was a well-organized introduction week with several opportunities to get to know and meet all other exchange students from all around the world. Due to its good reputation there are people not only from Europa which makes it very unique. We were more than 200 international students and the ESN-Network did an awesome job getting us into the feeling of Kozminski, and Poland. Warsaw can be reached by plane very easily and has an international airport and a smaller airport mainly conducted by Ryanair in the north of Warsaw (45min. by bus to get there) Prices differ regarding which Airline you choose.

### Studies and courses:

During my stay at Kozminski, I fulfilled the whole third semester of Liechtenstein by doing 30ECTS. I chose the courses from various Master's degree programmes (Finance 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> year, and the Master in Management 2<sup>nd</sup> year). Most of the courses are very practical which makes it interesting attending them. And physical attendance is something where Kozminski put a lot of emphasis on it. In most courses I was not the only exchange student and as the courses are Master and international, most people spoke English to each other rather than their native language. Which makes you feel pretty comfortable. The classes are often graded by a level of 100 points which you earn through group works, presentations, essays and assignments as well as exams. Especially group works are pretty common in making up most of the points. Compared to Liechtenstein you have several graded tasks and not only one big exam at the end.

The following table provides an overview about the courses I chose, the programme from which it was selected as well as the ECTS and the examination structure.
