**Awards:** **Best Paper Award** (VP Bank AG Liechtenstein, CHF 2'000) and **Impact Award** ((LIFE Climate Foundation Liechtenstein, CHF 2'000)  
A referee panel will appoint the awards.

**Deadline:** Final paper submission **latest April 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2019**. Feedback **latest April 16<sup>th</sup>, 2019**.
