Gesamteindruck Mobilitätsaufenthalt bitte kurz in 4-5 Sätzen beschreiben	The exchange semester in Bergen (NO) was a fantastic experience. Bergen is a lovely city, that offers a great variety on cultural events, despite its relatively small size. It is situated within a wonderful landscape of mountains, lakes and fjords, that invite you to outdoor activities, such as hiking, skiing or climbing.
Einreise/Ankunft Einreiseformalitäten, Visum	Since I am from Switzerland, moving to Norway was easy. I didn't need a visa.
Zimmersuche/Wohnen Hilfreiche Kontaktdaten	The school will help you to find an accommodation, which is managed by the student housing organization "Sammen". I lived in the biggest student housing, called "Fantoft", where students from all over the world are living. This offers a small club, a gym, a climbing wall and other sports facilities in the close surrounding.
Öffentliche Verkehrsmittel Bahn, Bus, Erreichbarkeit Uni	The public transport system is very good and always on time. The school can be reached by several bus lines (3,4,5,6,83). From the student housing Fantoft it takes you about 30 min to get to the school and 20min to the city center. However, there are also several smaller housing options in the city center or very close to the school.
Vorbereitung Studium Kursanmeldungsprozedere, Sprach- und Studiennachweise	The whole semester in BAS consists of one studio that contains all the lectures/inputs/workshops/integrations... Usually you have a choice of three studios with a very different focus on material and construction, politics and research or urban planning.
Infos Universität Lage, Grösse, Infrastruktur	The school, called BAS, which stands for Bergen School of Architecture, is the craziest architecture school that I have ever seen. It is located in an old, industrial building, just next to the sea. It offers a wonderful view and creates an atmosphere of creativity and freedom. Nothing is permanent in this school, nothing is straight or normal, everything is changing, improvised, artistic and wild... It is a school, where 1 st year students spend a month in a tent in nature to be confronted with basic needs, it is a place, where professors are fishing in front of the school, a school, where no chair is like the other. It has around 150 students.

Betreuung an der Universität Studienberatung, International Office, Buddy, Studierendenkontakte	The people from the Administration are very friendly and will help you, if you have any questions or problems.
Studieren an der Universität Kursinhalte, Anrechnungen, Prüfungen	Everything is integrated in one studio that will give you 30 ETCS. There are no grades in this school, either you pass or fail the semester. It consists of different workshops, lectures, desk crits and pin ups, lead by one main professors and several other teachers from different fields, such as geography, art or engineering.
Kostenplanung Lebenskosten, Studienmaterial,	Living in Norway is rather expensive, comparable to Switzerland or Liechtenstein, except of the alcohol, which is even more expensive. Regarding the studies, a lot of

<p>Leben/Freizeit Treffpunkte, Sport, Kultur</p>	<p>The city offers a great diversity of cultural events, museums and art galleries. There are endless options to go hiking and to spend a night on the wonderfully situated mountain cabins. For around 100 euros you can buy a membership to use the sports facilities provided by the University of Bergen, that contain swimming pools, saunas, climbing walls, gyms, etc. There are lots of small bars to go out in the evening.</p>

It is an inspiring place of creativity and freedom.</p> <p>However, this also brings along some issues of chaos and a lack of structure and organization. The quality and the quantity of the produced work by the students as well as the informations provided by the teachers are on a higher level in the University of Liechtenstein.</p>
