In 2017, University of Liechtenstein successfully conducted the "Workshop Sustainable Finance" for the first time. In 2020, we would like to continue this success story by offering our **fourth workshop** on May 5, 2020.

Our workshop meets the rapidly increasing interest in financial products, which promote a transformation towards a sustainable society. This workshop is aimed at researchers in the field of sustainable finance as well as employees in finance who want to deal with current research results and to identify emerging trends. With this platform we intend to intensify discussions between researchers and practitioners. Each paper presented will be discussed by an academic discussant as well as by a discussant from practice, offered by our partner VP Bank.

With a Call for Papers we invited research oriented academics at universities (PhD students, lecturers, professors, etc.) as well as consulting firms, associations, market authorities, etc. to contribute with papers on sustainable issues in banking & finance. Analytical, theoretical and empirical papers are welcome. As an example, topics could be on sustainable investing & finance, ESG related finance, (social) Impact Investing, renewable energy finance, etc.

A selection committee will nominate the best of the submitted proposals and invite the authors to our workshop. After completion of the selection process, authors and presentation titles will be listed on our homepage (at latest by March 25, 2020).

In the coming years, already implemented and under-paced regulatory projects will ensure that sustainability will severely affect business practices in general as well as actors and products of the financial industry. This workshop is designed to stimulate researchers, but also the financial practice, and provide guidance.

CALL FOR PAPERS

The Institute for Finance at the University of Liechtenstein is pleased to announce a call for papers for a small and exclusive conference on sustainable finance, which will be held on May 5th, 2020 at the University of Liechtenstein in Vaduz, Principality of Liechtenstein.

The aim of the workshop is to bridge a gap between academics and professionals on issues surrounding sustainable finance, with a primary focus on asset and investment management. As such we invite complete empirical and theoretical academic papers, which will be discussed both by an academic and a practitioner. Topics of special interest are, but not limited to:

- ESG related research (integration, materiality, risk relevance, etc.)
- Green bonds
- Low carbon portfolio management
- Sustainable Developments Goals (SDGs)
- Regulatory issues (MiFID II, IDD, Benchmark Regulation, etc.)
- Impact Investing
- EU Taxonomy on Sustainable Finance

Papers presented at the conference will be invited for submission to the Palgrave Macmillan Series "Studies in impact finance" and to the Topical Collection "Sustainability in Financial Industry" of the journal Sustainability.

Each accepted paper will be discussed by a practitioner from VP Bank AG Liechtenstein as well as by one of the speakers. Discussants will be assigned by the Chair in advance.

AWARDS

Additionally LIFE Climate Foundation Liechtenstein will award the "2020 Impact Award" (CHF 2,000) for the paper with the highest relevance for climate protection and sustainability.

Der Zertifikatsstudiengang "Blockchain und FinTech" bereitet Sie auf die Herausforderungen dieser veränderten Arbeitswelt im Finanzsektor vor. Die anwendungsorientierte Vermittlung von Kenntnissen im Bereich der technologischen Neugestaltung bestehender finanzwirtschaftlicher Systeme steht dabei im Vordergrund. Als Absolvent oder Absolventin des Programms verfügen Sie über ein grundlegendes Verständnis für die neuen, noch sichereren und vernetzten Systeme sowie deren Auswirkungen auf neue Geschäftsmodelle und Wertschöpfungsnetzwerke, die über bestehende Unternehmensgrenzen hinausgehen. Das vermittelte Wissen ist dabei breit angelegt und umfasst auch einen Überblick über technologische, rechtliche und steuerliche Aspekte. Start 2021 - Anmeldungen werden bereits entgegengenommen.

Executive Master of Laws (LL.M.) in International Taxation

Die ständigen Veränderungen des nationalen und internationalen Steuerrechts stellen eine der zentralen Herausforderungen für die internationale Besteuerung und Steuerplanung von grenzüberschreitend tätigen Unternehmen und Konzernen, aber auch für international über Vermögensstrukturen sowie direkt in Finanzinstrumente, Unternehmensbeteiligungen, Immobilien und Sachwerte investierende Privatpersonen und institutionelle Investoren dar. Diese Herausforderungen erfordern eine steuerliche Spezialausbildung, die sowohl bestimmte nationale und internationale Steuerordnungen und Steuersysteme als auch deren grenzüberschreitendes Zusammenspiel unter Berücksichtigung der verschiedenen Formen der internationalen Steuerkooperation sowie des europäischen Steuerrechts umfasst. Die Studieninhalte des Executive-Masterstudiengangs sind entsprechend konsequent auf konkrete grenzüberschreitende Fragestellungen und Fallgestaltungen ausgerichtet. **Start September 2020 - Anmeldungen werden bereits entgegengenommen.**
