- Step 1: Nomination by home university till October 11<sup>th</sup> (Spring) / April 1<sup>st</sup> (Fall)
- Step 2: Application till October 29<sup>th</sup> (Spring) / April 20<sup>th</sup> (FALL) (instructions will be sent after nomination)
- Step 3: Notification of admission (sent with all documents related to housing and visa process)\*see details on page 3
  - → Please note that admission depends on the prerequisites asked by each major (included in the syllabus of the selected major)
- Step 4: administrative registration in the selected major
- Step 5: orientation day (usually the first day of the semester)


