Application Process

- Nomination by home university till October 11th (Spring) / April 1st (Fall)
- Application till October 29th (Spring) / April 20th (Fall) instructions will be sent after nomination
- Notification of admission (sent with all documents related to housing and visa process)*see details on page 3

Please note that admission depends on the prerequisites asked by each major (included in the syllabus of the selected major)

- Administrative registration in the selected major
- Orientation day (usually first day of the semester)

Bachelor's degree (3 or 4 years in higher education) in Science or Technology

Language

English

- IELTS: 6.0 (minimum)

- TOEFL: 83 (IBT)

- TOEIC: 780

- OFFICIAL CERTIFICATE FROM ENGLISH TEACHER OF ENGLISH DEPARTMENT IS ACCEPTED (B2 LEVEL)

French

B2 Level in any of the following tests:

Deadlines:

Deadlines Fall 2020: April 1st (nomination) April 20th (application)

<u>Deadlines Spring 2021</u>: **October 11th** (nomination) **October 29th** (application)

Semester dates:

Fall 2020: From beginning of September to end of December, before Christmas

Spring 2021: From early January to mid-April



Mandatory for EU Citizens:

- European Health insurance Card
- Private insurance

Mandatory for Non EU Citizens:

• Enrolment in French social security system (free)
