Not on time, no direct connections, and you always have to run a lot. the bus card was worth it, because we don't have a car. But if I had stayed longer, I would have bought one. Because for our trips made on the weekend, we always had to rent a car.

Infos Universität Lage, Grösse, Infrastruktur	The university has around 2000 students, which is slightly larger than the University of Liechtenstein. The university is also a bit out of town and the bus connections are not the best. Because all local students come to the university by car. It is very modern equipped, and you had access to the university around the clock. The university was equipped with a supermarket, a café, gym and a cafeteria.

Kostenplanung Lebenskosten, Studienmaterial, Geldüberweisungen	<p>The cost of living in Iceland is surprisingly high (even compared to Switzerland). Especially what also concerns the alcohol. Therefore, shopping in the duty-free store at the airport is recommended. Before doing so, however, the permitted import quantities should be researched. Some products from Germany are often not easily found in Iceland. Thus, the products that are particularly important (for example, certain brands) can be an advantage. The study materials were provided by the instructors, therefore you did not have to spend much money on that. In addition, everything in Iceland is actually paid for by card. For this reason, cash is generally not needed.</p>	
Leben/Freizeit Treffpunkte, Sport, Kultur	<p>With the university you can make a gym subscription, which is a bit cheaper. However, I did not do this, because I still found it very expensive. Otherwise, you can see the very active Icelanders always walking or jogging along the coast (next to the university). The meeting places for most exchange students were the countless cafes and the university itself. The university also has a "chill place" with a sofa, table tennis, foosball and much more. The university also offers a very pleasant ambience that you also sometimes like to sit longer in the university with the others.</p> <p>Of course, traveling is also part of Iceland. It is so fascinating, and you discover the land of fire and ice from a completely new and beautiful point of view when you leave the city a bit. The company Bluecar Rental is highly recommended for renting cars, as Iceland has no rail transport.</p>
