But this is not a problem, because there are different websites that help you out to look for a place to stay, renting a room is not difficult if you have the meanings and are willing to pay a high amount for a small place to stay. The apartment where I lived consisted of four rooms, my roommates were students like me from different countries like (Taiwan, Venezuela, Netherlands). The house was located very central, just a short walk from Arc de Triumph and a nice subway ride of about 20 minutes to the University. The area was very safe, clean and with lots of opportunities to visit a nice small cafe or a restaurant nearby. |

The price for a monthly pass is 80 Euros a month and you can use all the buses and subway lines whenever you want and as many times you want.  |

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| Studies at the university<br>Course content, credits,<br>exams   | The advantages of studying under the Erasmus program are that you can choose courses<br>that are like our courses at Uni II: This is a unique opportunity to embrace the entire<br>program of your study course and makes it easier to see the full picture of study course,<br>especially if you are here just for one semester as an exchange student. The courses that<br>I took were in cyber Security, machine Learning and mathematics for data scientists. The<br>courses are time consuming normally the classes last about 3 hours plus an extra hour<br>for a Laboratory. The exams tend to be time under pressure about 1 hour or 1 :30. I<br>would suggest to prepare for the exams in advance because you will have to write most<br>of the exams in 3 days. Sometimes 3 exams in a day. |

The international office is a good help to answer lots of concerns and questions. Just send an email and they will answer very kindly.  |
| <b>Budgeting</b><br>Cost of living, study<br>materials, money transfers  | Cost of living in Paris will depend on your kind of life style you are used to have. Food in Paris tend to be more expansive than in other countries, dining out with some friends can also be kind of expensive. I would budget 1200 euros a month if living outside of downtown. If you are living in downtown, I would budget 1700 euros per month or even more. Including accommodation, monthly pass, going out, etc.  |
| <b>Life / Leisure</b><br>Places to meet, sports,<br>culture  | Beside the French cuisine is represented in numerous boulangeries, patisseries, small<br>bistros, and plenty of restaurants in the city, is the importance of museums.
