Visa	Students from outside the UK and Ireland are likely to require a visa to study at the GSA. If studying for less than six months (e.g. Semester long exchanges) you can join GSA with a Standard Visitor Visa. Students coming to the GSA for more than six months are required to apply for a Student Visa from the UK Visa and Immigration department (UKVI)
Accommodation Options (Glasgow campus)	Accommodation isn't guaranteed, though applications for GSA Halls of Residence, can be made once Exchange Decisions have been communicated.
